



Mission: Future Projection – Featuring Fate's Polly Pocket

Mission Author: Fate

Mission Goal: Test the effectiveness of Fate's Super Secret (until now) Polly Pocket Routine.

DEADLINE: Monday, December 14th

Description:

You know what I would do with you guys? I would teach you...a way...to attract women...by letting them vivify...a wild experience...anchored to you...and we could fly...all around the country...meeting women together. Then, we'd come right back...to this very place...and everyone would be super jealous...because we would be...super-charged unstoppable Stylelife Academy social artists. Does that sound far-fetched? I can promise you it isn't.

Rationale:

The most sure-fire way to create attraction in any human being, male or female, is to show them that you live in a reality so strong and so compelling that they cannot resist it. Among my favorite ways of accomplishing this goal is to use a Future Projection. Future Projections are unrealistic, adventurous stories that take place in the future involving yourself and your audience.

Instructions:

There are a number of ground rules to follow when using Future Projections. Failing to follow these rules can lessen the effect of a good projection. Let's take a look at these rules, and then take a look at some specific Future Projection scripts.

GROUND RULE #1:

Non-Fiction Can't Shake a Stick at Fantasy.

The best Future Projections tap into this axiom. Fantasy is compelling. If you can allow a woman to live out a dream, the emotional effect will be incredible. For example, I could create a Future Projection about taking a woman on a trip to Disney world with me, but I could make it even more effective by telling her something like the following:

And we would ride Space Mountain...but our roller coaster car...would be a real rocket ship...and we could fly...all over the galaxy...etc.

Even if you do not employ this degree of fantasy, giving yourself or your audience super-human powers or advanced technology enhances the projection.

GROUND RULE #2:



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Anchor Togetherness.

Nobody wants to hear about you living out your fantasies alone. Furthermore, while she might have a great time thinking about her own fantasies, she'll quickly forget the facilitator in favor of the experience. A good Future Projection will project you and her living out a fantasy together. The connection does not have to be romantic, but both you and your audience must be present in the fantasy, and should mutually enjoy the experience.

GROUND RULE #3:
Be Positive.

This rule should be self-evident. We're talking about fantasy here, so make sure it's a happy one. Failing to follow this rule can make your Future Projections very unwelcome. I once heard a friend of mine use the following Future Projection:

You know what I would do with you...I would lock you up...in a tall tower...guarded by a dragon...and I would...

That's about as far as he got before his audience stormed off. He certainly projected a fantasy world, but he was not positive, so this projection came off as creepy and unwelcome.

GROUND RULE #4:
Bring it Back.

A good Future Projection doesn't just go off into a fantasy world and stay there forever. One of the most important aspects of solid Future Projection strategy is what I call the 'return to normalcy,' (to quote Warren G. Harding).

At the end of your Future Projection, you want to bring the action back to the current situation. You do not need to return to the current time (and unless your projection involves faster-than-light travel, you can't), but you should return to the current place.

In the example projections I will give later, notice the similarities in the endings. Most of my Future Projections return to the present situation, while commenting on our elevated social status.

GROUND RULE #5:

Be Spontaneous.

While scripted Future Projections are great, the delivery must seem spontaneous for the projection to be believable. You have probably noticed that when I write out my projections, I use '...' to denote long pauses. Be comfortable in these brief instances of silence. Do not feel rushed. Be confident and savor the moment.



Now that you know the rules of Future Projections, let me share some of my favorites with you. I personally enjoy making up Future Projections on the fly, but if you are less versed in improvisation, stock projections work just fine. All of these examples were improvised first, and revised later.

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The Space Mountain Rocket-ship

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You know what we could do? We could take a trip...to Disney World...and we could ride Space Mountain...but our roller coaster car...would be a real rocket ship...and we could fly...all over the galaxy...and Mickey could come too...and we would have all kinds of crazy adventures...but don't tell Minnie...she'll just get mad...and then...we could come right back to this bar...and everyone would be super jealous...because you would be my Space Mountain rocketeer princesses!!

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Fate's Polly Pocket

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You know what I would do with you? I would shrink you down... (make pinching motion with fingers) like this big...and I would get you...a little plastic case...and that could be your home...You could deck it out...granite countertops and wall to wall carpeting, baby...the works...and I would keep you...in my pocket...And when people messed with me...I'd let you out, and you could tickle them (tickle her)...and they'd know not to mess with me...you would be...my Polly Pocket tickle attack troll.

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Ninja Candy

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You know what I would do with you guys? I would dress you up...like ninja warriors...but with little bows on your heads so we'd still know you were girls...and we would use our super secret ninja powers...to steal all the tootsie rolls in the world...and give them to the children of mean parents...and then they would rise up...on little sugar highs...and overthrow the establishment...with their rattles and dolls and stuff...and no one would know that it was us...because we're ninjas...and then



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we'd come right back here, to this very spot, and we would watch the news and smile...because we would be...the Ninja Robin Hoods of candy and revolution!!

Test any of these Future Projections, and post your results.

Test The Future Projection Routine:

1. Does it work successfully?
2. How difficult is this routine to master?
3. Did you get called out on using this routine?
4. What is the hook point strength of this routine?
5. Rapport building strength?
6. Your PUA-AFC level?
7. Number of times tested?
8. Any additional insight?
9. Suggested Additions of Modifications to routine (if any):

Reason to test:

The Sneak has joked that this is the only routine you will ever need to pick up and seduce any woman, and referenced it in many of his Field Reports (Check out stylelife.com to read some of his adventures with Fate). After telling some friends we were testing this they all said that if done right then this was one of the more powerful things you can do while interacting with a woman.

They also couldn't believe that we were sharing this.

Follow the rules and test to see how it works for you!
