



Mission: The Jinx Opener

Mission Authoring Coach: Evolve

Mission Goal: Test the Jinx Opener

Description:

Night clubs can be a pain in the ass sometimes. On nights when the clubs are packed and the music is louder than ever, it's tough for an aspiring social artist to have his voice heard. Learning proper body language is a key component to success in these tough situations. The reason I mention vocal abilities and body language is because I don't want you to forget their importance in light of the following opener. The Jinx opener needs little to no body language skills and absolutely no verbal skills.

A good one to know if you've recently had your mouth sewn shut by a tyrant king after having been caught orally pleasing his beautiful and strangely sexually adventurous daughter.

Rationale:

I came up with this opener a year ago after a several students sent me emails regarding loud clubs.

I went out to the loudest most packed clubs I could find in my area, and experimented with some "silent openers." The first week I didn't have much success. A few sets opened but nothing that amazing.

A week later I went out with one of my old girlfriends. The two of us started talking about one of our friends clothing style. We simultaneously said the same word, "pants."

She said, "Jinx you can't speak until someone says your name."

She had given me the answer I had been looking for - after testing the opener a few times I was eager to get my work up on the forums.

I created a thread on the boards then deleted it a few days later because my science brain started telling me that there wasn't sufficient data to post the opener. I knew more testing needed to be done.

About three months later I found out that there were a number of students actually out there using it in field thanks to Bravo who enjoyed the post, saved it and gave it to a few local students who were having trouble opening.



Instructions:

Evolve's Jinx Opener:

What you need:

- Paper (napkin)
- Pen

Grab a napkin from the bar -

Write on one side of the napkin,

"My friend just Jinxed me! I can't speak until someone says my name."

On the back write,

"Don't give me that 'He's hitting on me' face, you're not even my type."

In the middle write,

[your name]

The approach:

Make your approach frantic; as though you are searching for anyone you can find to help you out. Take the napkin and put it in the hand of your target.

Let her read the napkin. She'll laugh or look at you like you're a weirdo, the latter being *more* effective in this case. After she reads the front, regardless of her reaction, flip over the napkin so she can see the disqualifier side of the napkin.

Make sure everyone sees the napkin when you hand it to the girl. During the time you're unable to speak, use a lot of extreme body language to get the group to laugh and play along. Think of it like charades.

When they ask what your name is open up the napkin and show it to them.

Once they know your name and unjinx you you'll have a thoroughly opened set.

Of course, the whole group will laugh. You will now be the most exciting person they've met all night.

Notes:

- Once you can speak you've already hit a hook point, you can either stack on another opener or DHV.



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- It's great in a crowded nightclub because you don't have to speak. There are no noise issues. If they won't unjinx you... you could always pretend they did, and then blame the confusion on the noise. Regardless the set is open as long as they are having fun.
- If you have a pivot you can have her approach by saying: "Don't say his name! He's only got bad things to say!" This will make the story look real; it will solidify the root.
- One of the clubs I had used the Jinx opener at had black napkins. Prepare yourself like I did by purchasing a metallic silver sharpie if you've never been to the club or bar before or if you know that they have dark colored napkins.

Testing the Jinx Opener:

1. Does it open successfully?
2. How difficult is this routine to master?
3. Did you get called out on using this routine?
4. What is the hook point strength of this routine?
5. Rapport building strength?
6. Your PUA-AFC level?
7. Number of times tested?
8. Any additional insight?
9. How did you transition out of this opener? (Give specific details)

Reason to test:

Evolve needs to be validated. He's a ten and needs compliments on his work, his looks, and his intelligence to keep his self-esteem up. Also, he honestly believes that his opener is awesome - so give it a shot.

Follow up:

Come back to www.PickUpLabs.com and post after you test the Jinx Opener this weekend. Post links to any audio or video you were able to capture. Post your results and your findings on the 1-9 list above and use a 1-5 scale by the end of the day Monday. Tuesday there will be a new post where we crunch all of the data and either give this routine the Pick Up Labs stamp of approval or mark it as unapproved.
